The Shamrocks traveled to Lincoln to down previously undefeated Cathedral. Playing on a rain drenched field, the Irish punched across an early TD then concentrated on defense to top the Capital City lads 7-6.

St. Bonaventure chalked up its 4th straight victory in the annual homecoming game, defeating Omaha, St. Joseph 25 to 13.

Powerful Omaha, Holy Name, the Class B Champs blanked the Shamrocks in their next outing 30-0. The Ramblers showing a wealth of size, speed and precision in grinding out their 6th straight victory.

Chalking up the 5th victory St. Bonaventure downed Fremont, St. Pat's 52-0. With the combined offense and defense working smoothly the Irish had little trouble.

Deadlocked at halftime St. Bonaventure came back after intermission to dominate play with jarring, tackling, hard blocking, and a deceptive attack to down the invading Sidney Maroons 18 to 12.
