The season opener saw St. Bonaventure roll up plenty of yardage but fail to come up with the payoff punch, losing 6-0 to Blair.

Displaying a smooth offense and a stubborn defense, St. Bonaventure chalked up the first victory over Class (A) Omaha Cathedral 18-6, at Creighton Stadium.

St. Bonaventure earned a hard fought victory over Hastings, St. Cecilia 13-6. St. Cecilia outyarded the Irish the first half but after intermission St. Bon's dominated the play allowing the invaders only one first down.

The Shamrocks traveled to Lincoln to down previously undeafeted Cathedral. Playing on a rain drenched field, the Irish punched across an early TD then concentrated on defense to top the Capital City lads 7-6.

St. Bonaventure chalked up its 4th straight victory in the annual homecoming game, defeating Omaha, St. Joseph 25 to 13.

Powerful Omaha, Holy Name, the Class B Champs blanked the Shamrocks in their next outing 30-0. The Ramblers showing a wealth of size, speed and precision in grinding out their 6th straight victory.

Chalking up the 5th victory St. Bonaventure downed Fremont, St. Pat's 52-0. With the combined offense and defense working smoothly the Irish had little trouble.

Deadlocked at halftime St. Bonaventure came back after intermission to dominate play with jarring, tackling, hard blocking, and a deceptive attack to down the invading Sidney Maroons 18 to 12.

The Holy Name Ramblers, rolling in high gear downed the visiting Irish 71-28. Schuyler edged the Shamrocks in a close game, winning 43-39.

St. Bonaventure captured the first win of the season by downing Lincoln Cathedral 56-51.

The Irish handed St. Pat's of Fremont their first loss at the State Catholic Tournament at Hastings 45-41. St. Bon's were defeated by Holy Name in the semi-finals 69-38.

St. Pat's of Fremont defeated the Shamrocks 70-57 on the home court. Lincoln Teachers handed the Irish their next loss 49-31 at the Colliseum. St. Bonaventure beat St. Edward 56-52, on the St. Edward court for their third victory.

The Irish trounced St. Francis of Humphrey 67-51 for their fourth victory. St. Joseph of Omaha turned back the Shamrocks on their home court 74-57. Traveling to Stanton for the Stanton Tourney, the Irish were defeated 64-51 by Leigh, and 65-61.by Wayne.

The Irish turned back Osceola on the Columbus court 69-48 for their fifth victory. St. Bonaventure gained their sixth victory at the expense of Seward Concordia, 58 to 51.

The Irish traveling to Wayne were defeated 81-71.

Powerful Clarkson pulled away in the second half to beat the Irish 71-53, on the Columbus court.

Traveling to Wahoo to play the District Tournament, the Irish lost to David City 57-50

The Shamrocks played their last game of the season at Blair, winning 55-50.


