

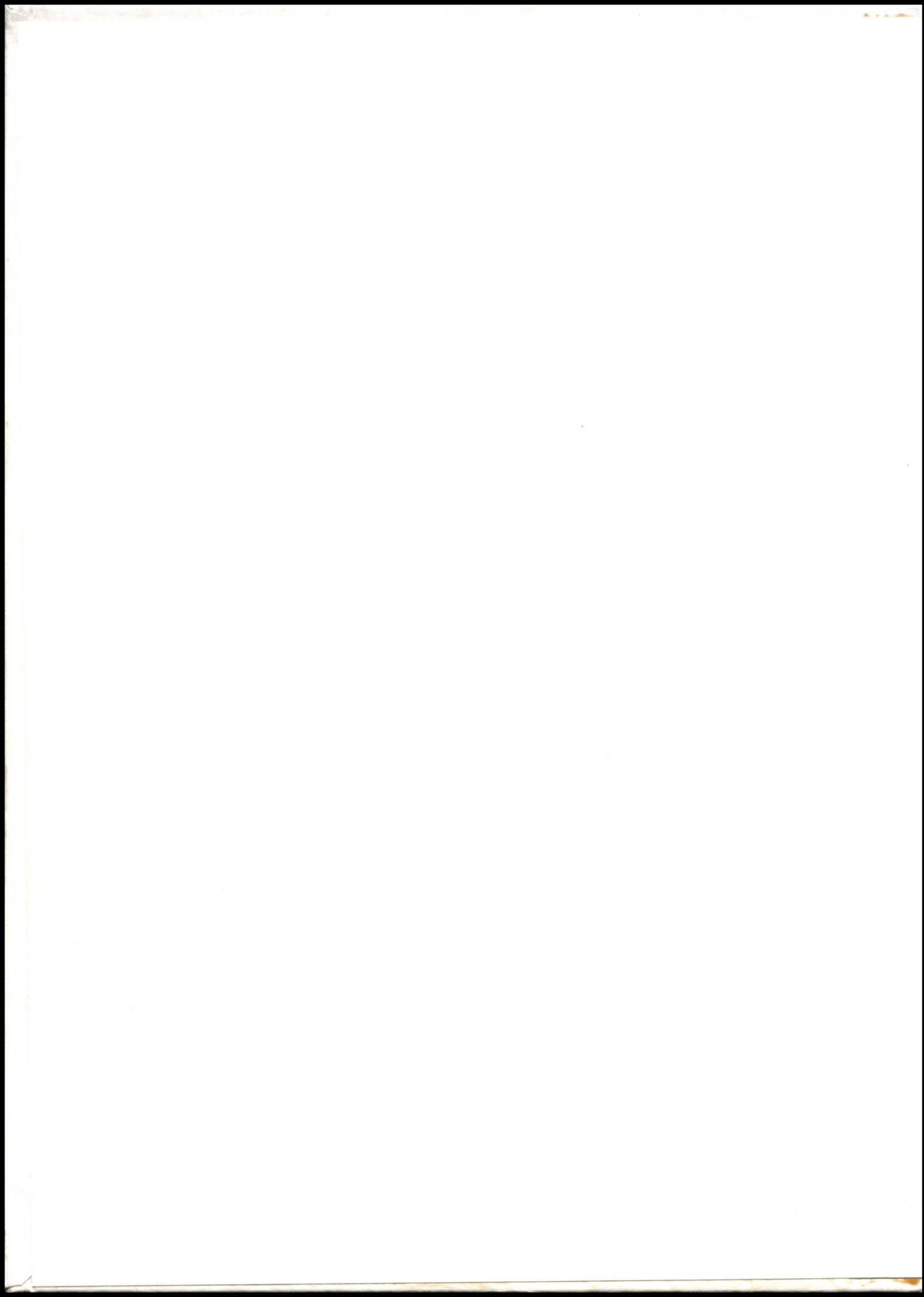

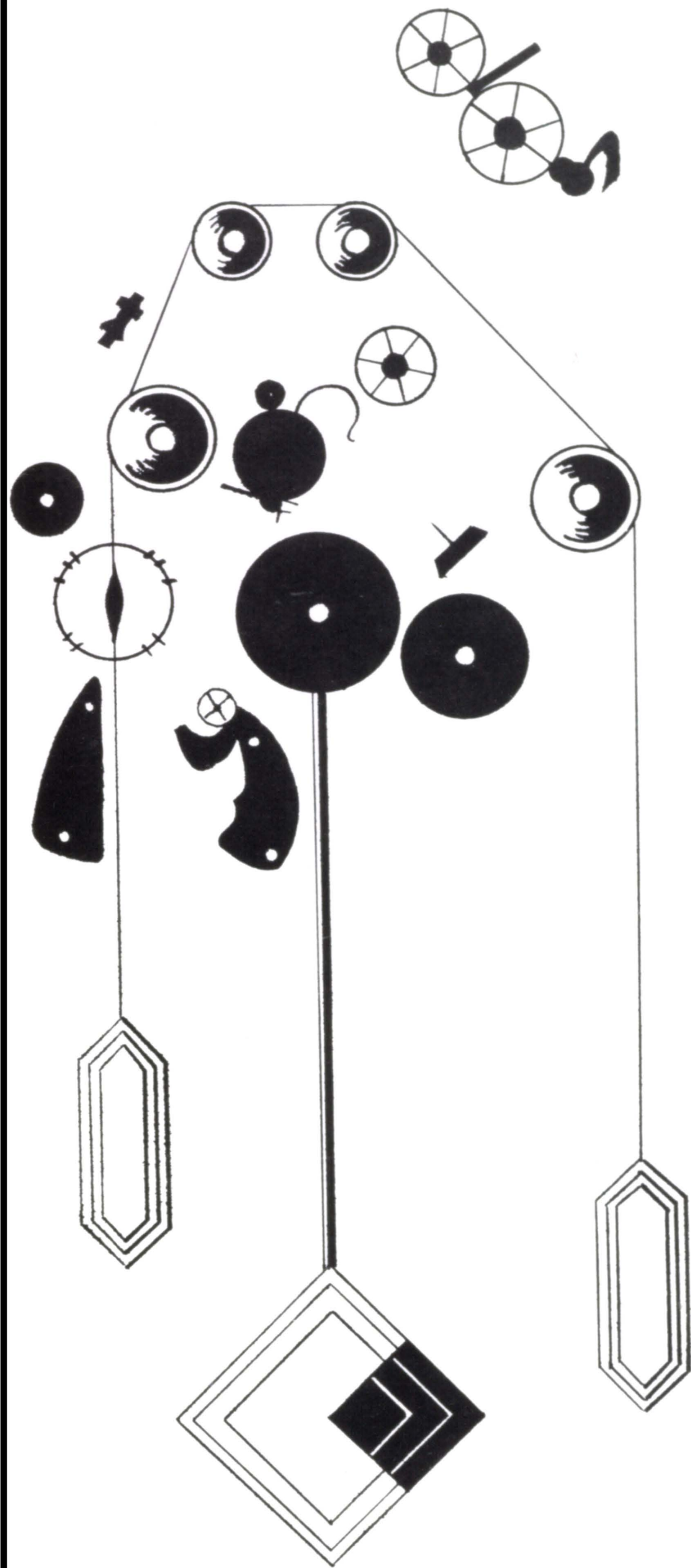

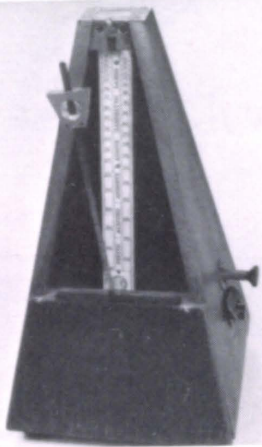
DEDICATION

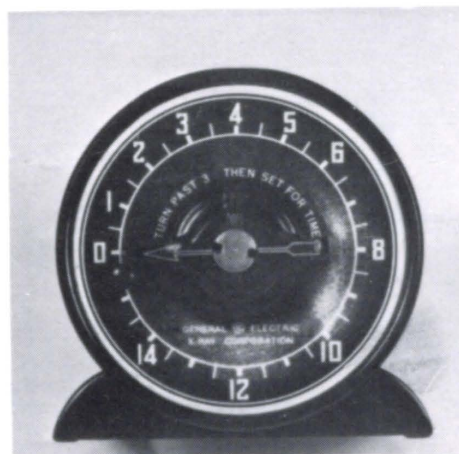
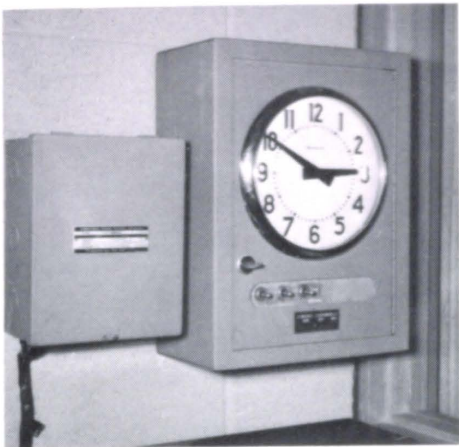


FOREWORD
