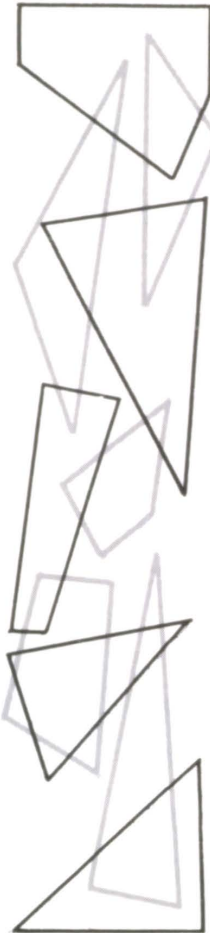


## FOREWORD

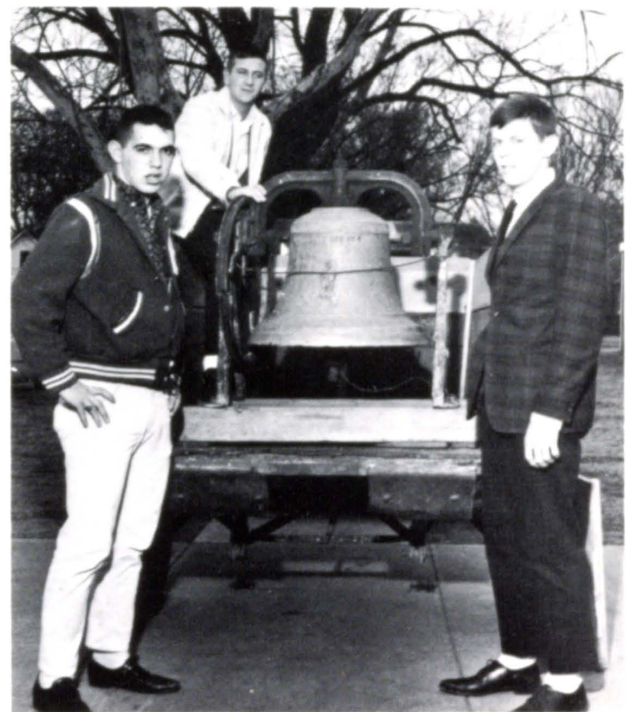
