Coach Pat Keitges, head track and football coach for the past two years and assistant coach prior to that time, has resigned to take on coaching responsibilities at Fremont Bergan.

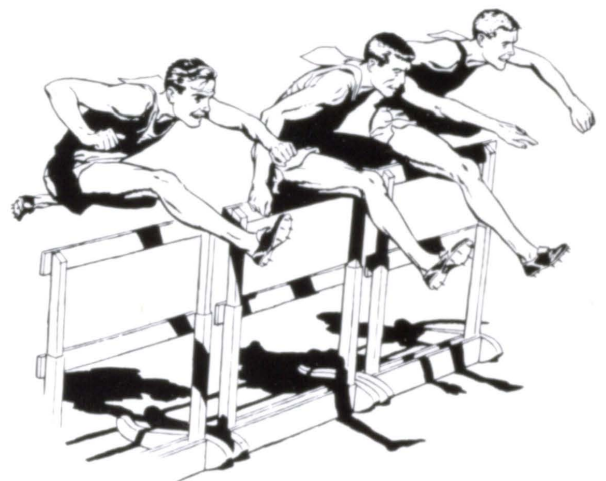

The nine girls composing the triple trio, calling themselves the "Shades of Green," made several public appearances throughout the year.

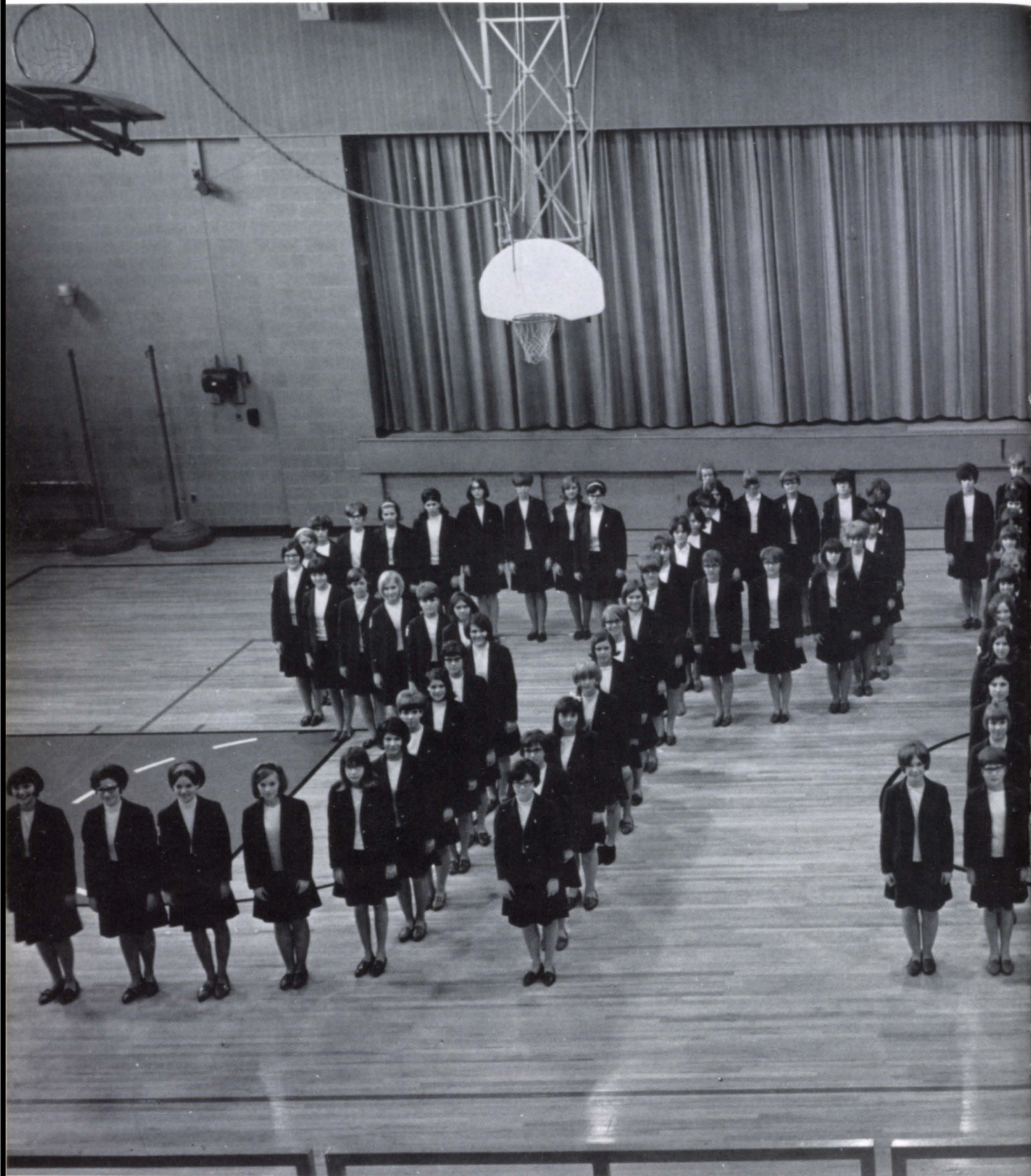
