SENIOR RETREAT

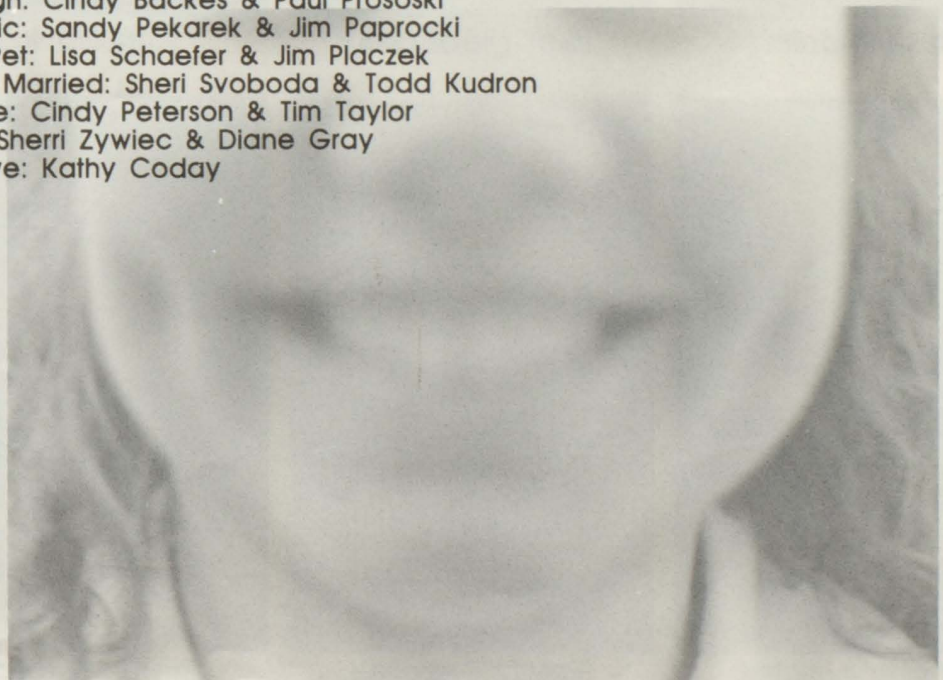

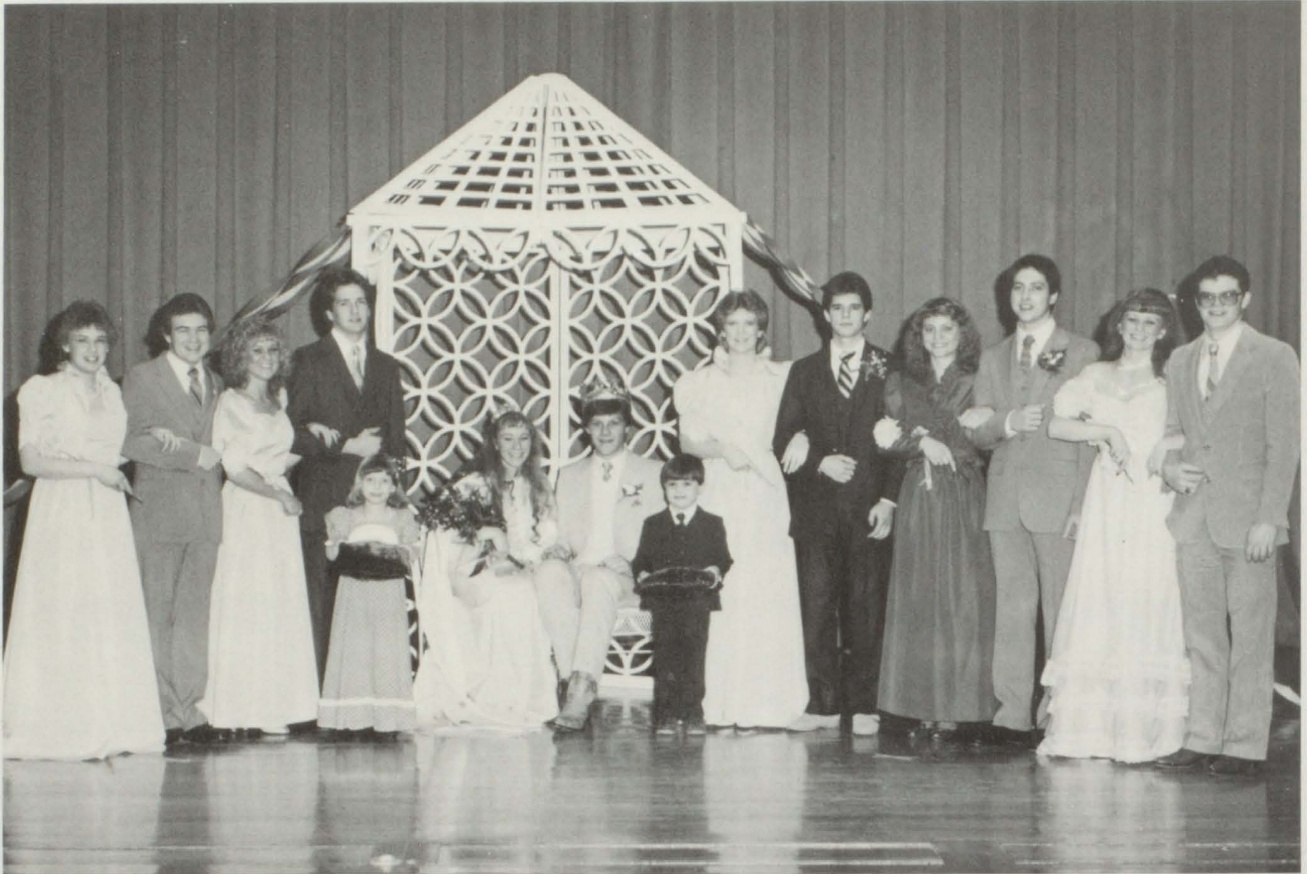


The music for the evening was provided by the Knights of the Round Table D. J.'s. They played everything from "Stairway to Heaven" to "Whip It".

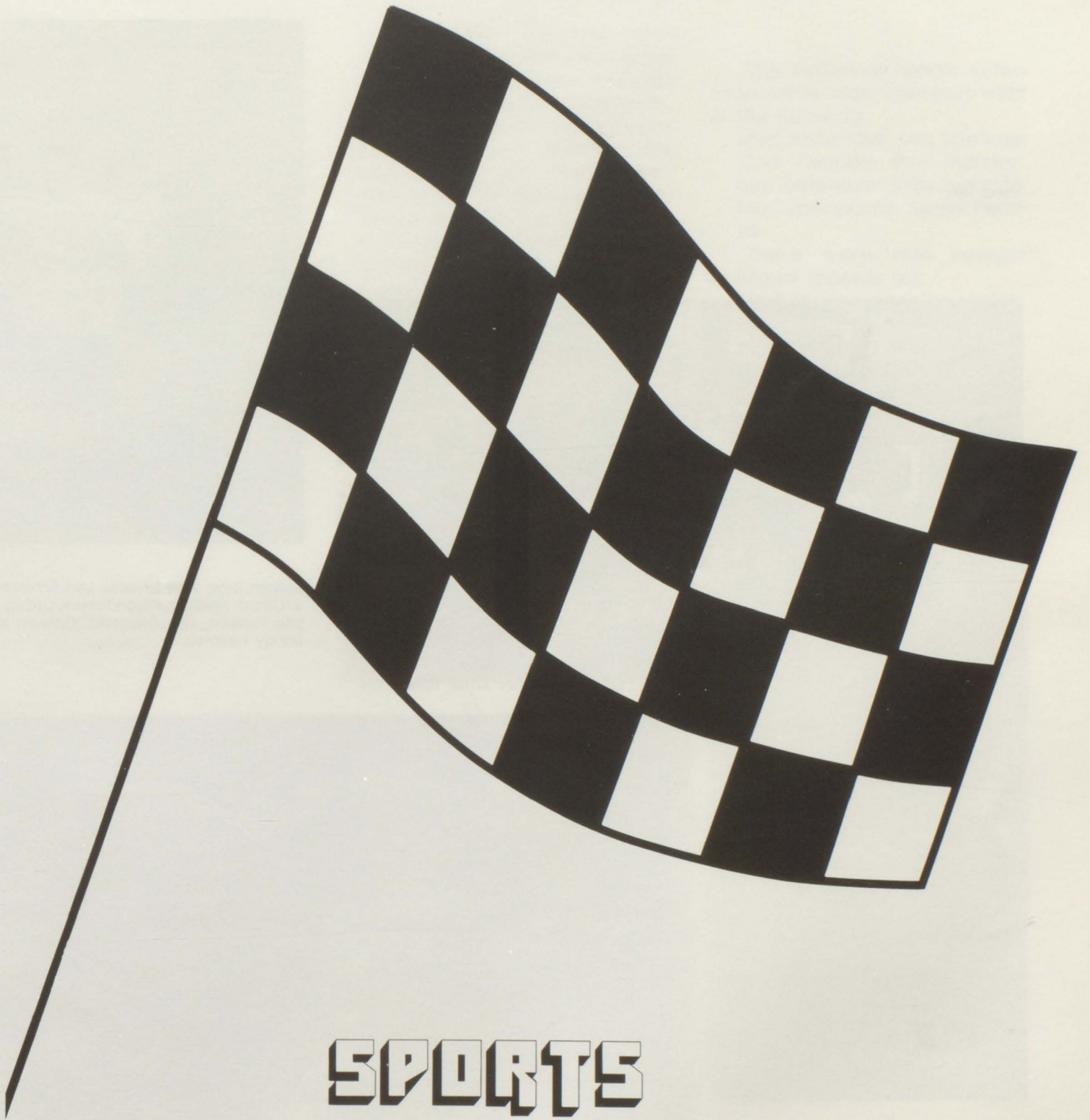
