





SENIOR RETREAT

new clubs to join, and just being part of the Senior High.


The year was filled with memories such as learning a foreign language, cheering in Pep






This year the team adopted a little girl from India, Reena. A certain amount of money is sent to her each month for her support.

Campus Ministry also continued to sell concessions at the girls' volleyball and basket ball games, and they held a tape dance in February, with all proceeds going to the needy.







