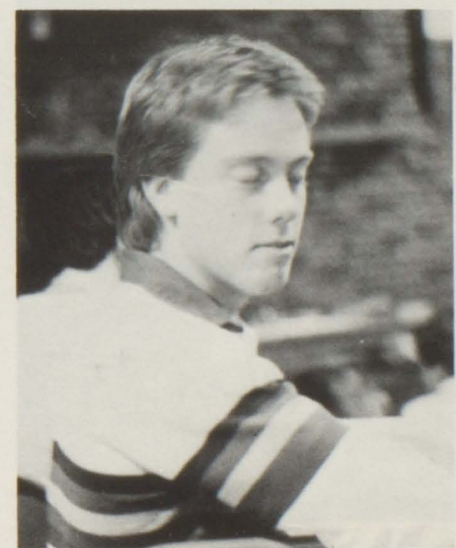


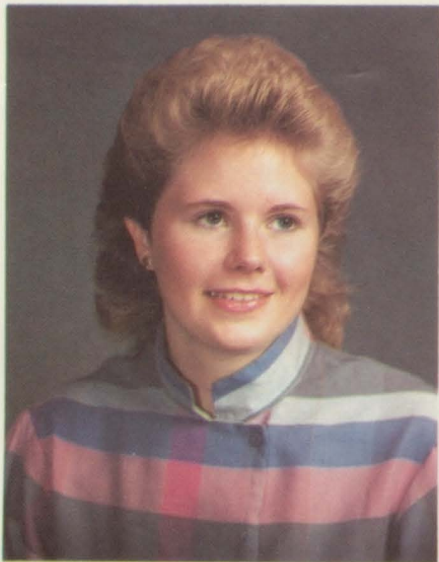
Senior Retreat

October 5 turned out to be a very exciting and memorous occasion. Homecoming 84 will long be remembered.



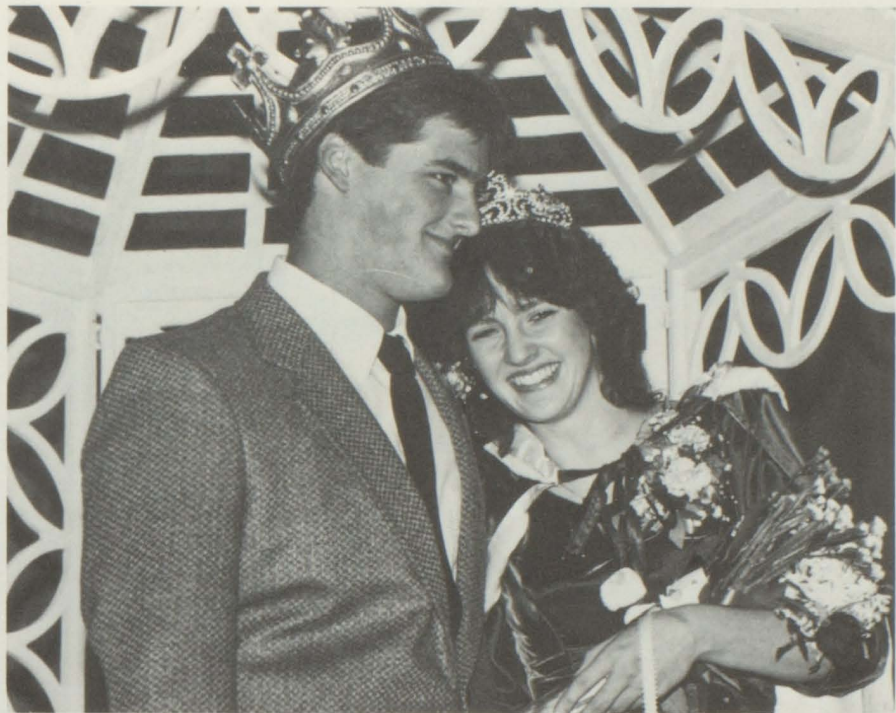
