## WHAT IS DUAL CREDIT?

A course that a student can receive high school AND college credit in.

Scotus partners with Central Community College to offer the following dual credit courses:

*Accelerated English 12*  
*Advanced Biology*  
*Advanced Math*  
*Calculus*  
*Physics*  
*Pre-Calculus*

## WHAT DUAL CREDIT COURSES DOES SCOTUS OFFER?

## HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Dual credit courses taught by Scotus teachers cost \$50/credit hour. Courses taught by college professors cost \$35/credit hour.

Registration forms to receive college credit will be given to students during the 23-24 school year.

## HOW DO I RECEIVE COLLEGE CREDIT?

## DO I HAVE TO RECEIVE COLLEGE CREDIT?

No! You can take the course for just high school credit. In this case, you would not pay for the class.

Most colleges have a transfer agreement with CCC. This means the course will transfer & count towards your college degree. Although if you have concerns, check with Ms. Brichacek!
