

August is here and that means we are approaching a new school year with rejuvenated students and staff returning to the halls of Scotus Central Catholic. I am excited to see all of our students on the 15th and equally excited to see parents at different events throughout the year.



This year we have five new teachers joining us as Shamrocks... Heidi Field will be teaching physical education and strength training.

A couple noticeable improvements that were made include the painting of Rooms 8 and 12 (including a new look to the closet doors in Room 8), new carpet in Room 8, and a new red stage curtain in the social hall.

Finally, our Home and School Board has recently met to plan engagement activities for the year. Representatives will be present at our Aug. 1 registration to help our parents sign up for volunteer opportunities, and they will provide a little treat at our Aug. 13th school open house. The end of summer is rapidly approaching, and we are almost ready to welcome students and staff back into the building. It has been a busy summer at school, which included some great updates! The classroom projector project is now complete thanks to the 2024 Shrimp Peel



funds. We have new LED lighting in our hallways thanks to SEF donors. Classroom 2B and the Student Support rooms received new carpet thanks to another generous donor. The Lowry lot, a small play area on the NE corner of school, will be ready for individual classroom/grade level usage in August.

We will welcome 209 students to our classrooms on August 15th. We also welcome several new staff members. Five new teachers will be joining us this year:

Mrs. Przymus (3rd grade,) Mrs. Hron (3rd grade,) Mr. Baker (PE,) Miss Hupp (Music,) and Mrs. Downs (Reading Interventionist.) We welcome two new paraeducators: Mrs. Samek (kdg,) and Mrs. Forney (3rd-5th grades.) The remainder of our staff has returned and everyone is excited for a successful year ahead!

The Parish Hall project is continuing, and our construction entrance will continue to be the "ramp doors" this fall, which are now under an awning. At some point this year, hopefully around January, we will start using the new hall entrances, and the school's secure entry/buzzer will be back to its original location, next to the school office.

Big lunch changes are coming! This year we will be allowing students to bring sack lunches from home whenever they choose. Our cafeteria will offer one hot entree per day, and we will NOT offer any "Cold Lunch" options this year since we are allowing sack lunches. We will remain an Allergy Aware building, due to students with life-threatening allergies. We request that all student sack lunches and snacks be peanut-free, and there will be a very strict No-Sharing rule. If students are found to be sharing food, they will be restricted from bringing a sack lunch for a period of time, so please remind your child of the No-Sharing rule if they choose to bring a lunch or snack from home.

For all of our allergy students, parents can choose to have them sit at a peanut-free table in the cafeteria (they can invite a friend with a school lunch to sit with them,) or sign a waiver allowing them to sit with their classmates. Any shared treats for birthdays or class parties must be peanut free, store-packaged & unopened, with an ingredient label attached. No homemade or home-prepared foods are allowed for class sharing! Watch nutrition labels for the bold ingredients (peanuts), or the disclaimer "May contain peanuts," and please do not send those items to school, as they will be sent back home.

Our office will keep an open door for all of our parents and parishioners for questions, conversations, or to help with all your Scrip gift card needs. We are excited for another great year partnering with your family. Enjoy the remaining summer days!

Scotus Central Catholic Picture Day is Wednesday, August 14, 2024

Proofs: About 1 to 2 weeks after Picture Day you will receive a Proof of your student's 2 poses.

The Proof has the Website and Password to place your order online.

If you do not wish to pay with a credit card: Still place the order online and select Cash or Check as the method of payment upon checkout. Place cash or check in the Payment Envelope that came with your Proof. Write your Order Confirmation Number from your online order on the Payment Envelope.

The Picture Packages you order will arrive approximately 2-3 weeks after the Due Date printed on the Proof.

<u>Family Plan</u>: When you pay for two children in your family, this qualifies you for a FREE package of equal or lesser value for all other children in your family.

If you qualify for the Family Plan, please email info@pegasus-si.com with the two Order Confirmation Numbers that have been paid in full along with the Order Confirmation Number for the order that is FREE. Please be sure to order and send email prior to the Due Date on the proof to avoid any late fees – Do NOT wait for all student's proofs as deadline dates may vary if they attend another school or are a Retake. Your FREE order is ON HOLD until you email the Confirmation Numbers.

For the 3rd order or more, use payment type FAMILY and click APPLY, then submit your online order.

Retakes: If you prefer to have a retake, you may do so for any reason on Retake Day. Wait until you get your RETAKE Proof to place an order at that time. If you decide to order from your original Proof rather than the Retake, you'll receive a late fee, as it is past the Order Due Date.

<u>Due Date</u>: On your proof is an Order Due Date. If you submit your order AFTER the Due Date, you'll have a \$10 late fee and late orders can take up to 6 – 8 weeks after ordering.
